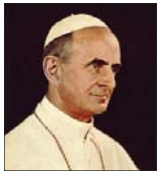

*Here in Benin, the pandemic is still very much present. Not even ten per cent of the populace is able to get COVID-19 vaccines because the solidarity between us (rich countries and poor countries) is not working as it should be and our government cannot provide them for*

*In our missionary's life, God has been so good to us: we organize, time to time, charity for the neediest. We have also opened another mission territory in a remote area of the country. This is a sign of hope for the faithful, for they believe and trust that they have not been abandoned by the Church. **EPISTLE:** Colossians 3: 12-17 Brethren: Put ye on therefore, as the elect of God, holy, and beloved, the depths of mercy, benignity, humility, modesty, patience: bearing with one another and forgiving one another if any have a complaint against another. And let the peace of Christ rejoice in your hearts, wherein also you are called in one body: and be ye thankful. 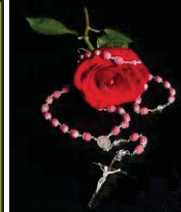

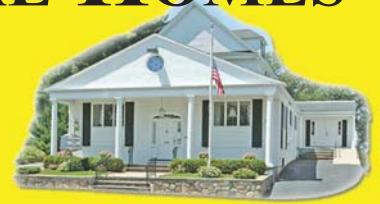

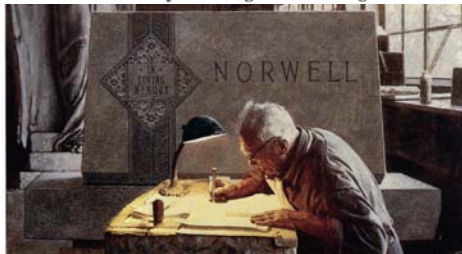
