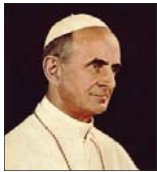

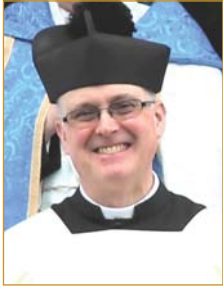

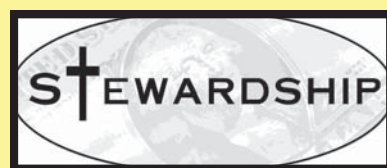


I want to thank and recognize **Sharon Hogan** our Business Manager, for her important role in the business end of our Cemetery management.

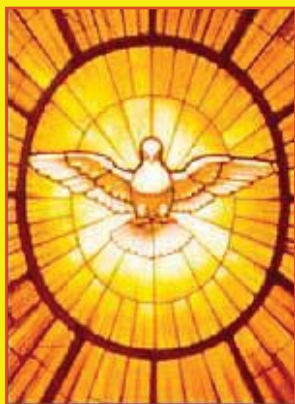

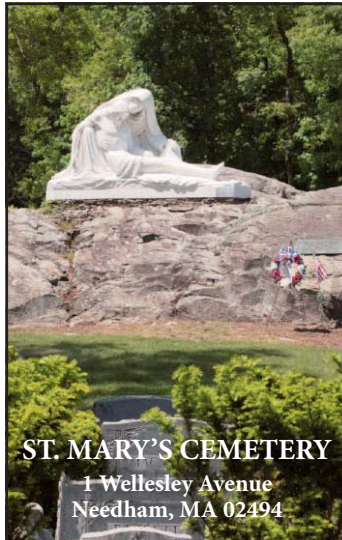

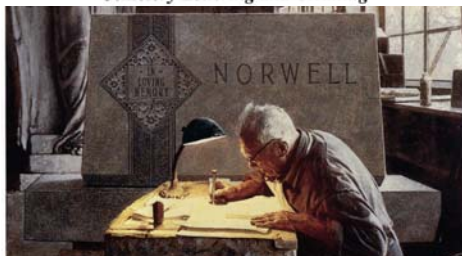
