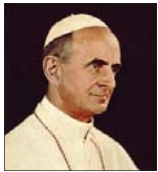

On the 9th Day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the 18th Day of May will be the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the 28th Day of May, the Feast of Pentecost.

On the 8th Day of June, the Feast of Corpus Christi.

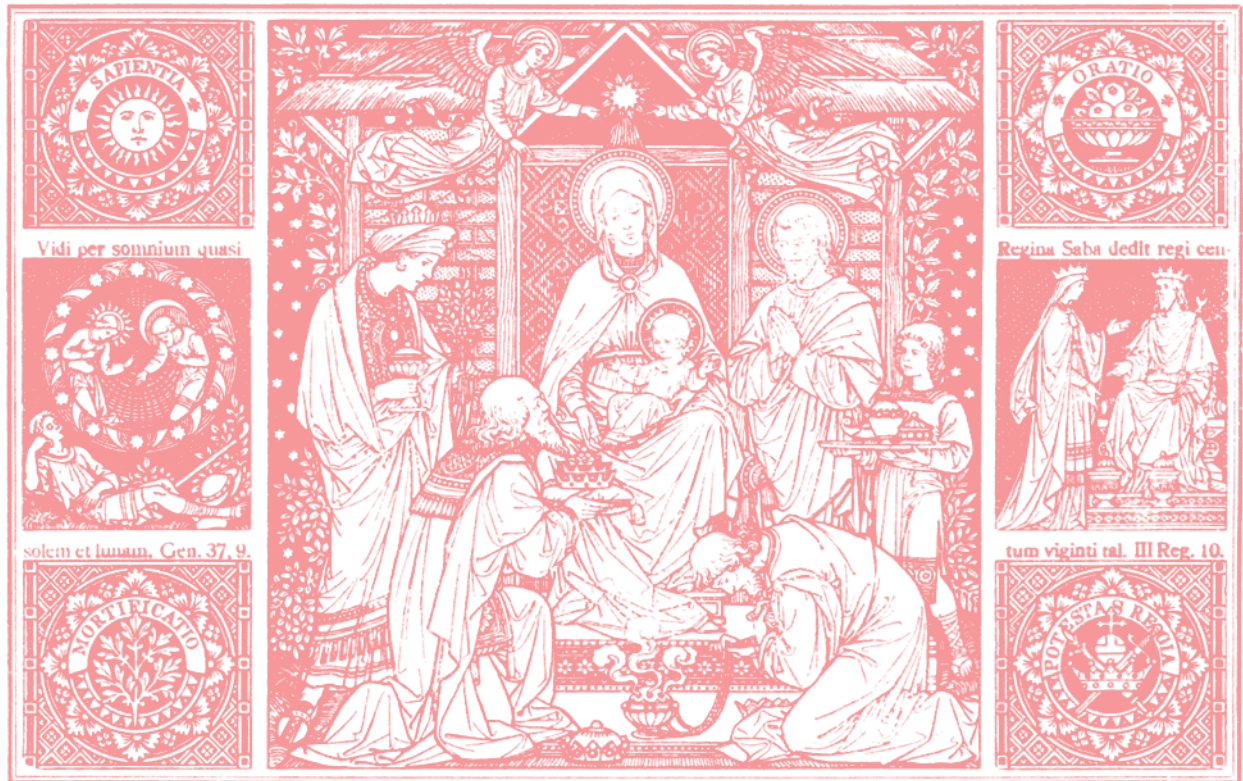

O God, make the door of this house wide enough to receive all who need human love and companionship, narrow enough to shut out all envy, pride and strife. Make its threshold smooth enough to be no stumbling block to children, nor to straying feet, but rugged and strong enough to turn back the Tempter's power. 

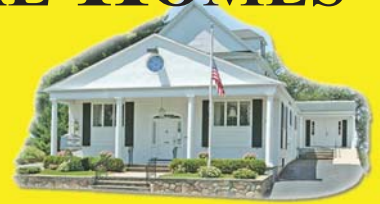

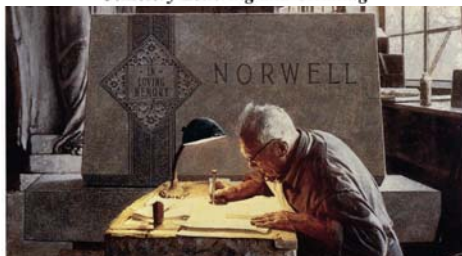
